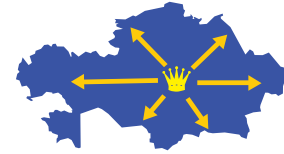

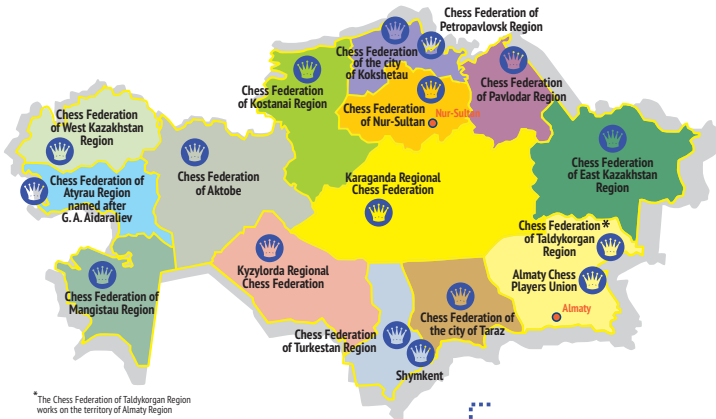

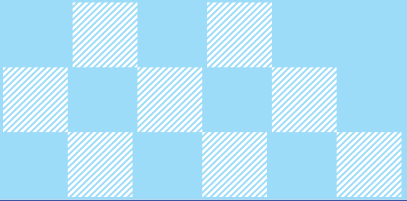
BRANCHES OF THE FEDERATION
